

- 1,784 children, adolescents, families and adults
  with developmental disabilities received support
  to help heal from trauma, build resiliency,
  overcome challenges, and strengthen their
  abilities and families.
- 209 foster families were recruited, trained and supported.
- 100% of adolescent offenders in our Non-Secure Detention program were allowed to return home to their families.
- 100% of our adults with developmental disabilities who no longer have family involvement had formed a new Abbott House family with our staff, volunteers, and mentors.
- 60% of our teens secured summer employment which is almost twice the national average.
- 100% of adolescents and teens received life skills programming.
